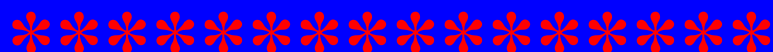

Brodak fly-in 2017

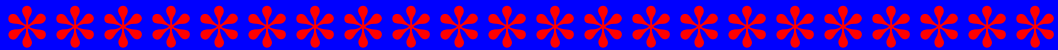

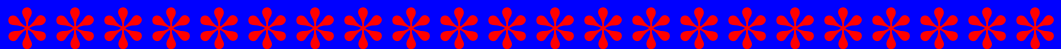

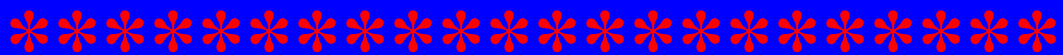

With freedom comes the responsibility of choice. God's desire for man is to be free to choose. When you follow Christ it is your freewill choice to do so.

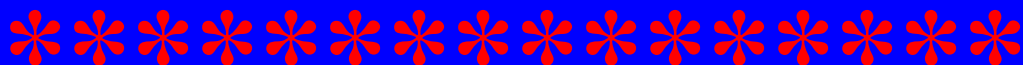

Freedom is attractive. Many will be won to Jesus because in Him we are truly free.

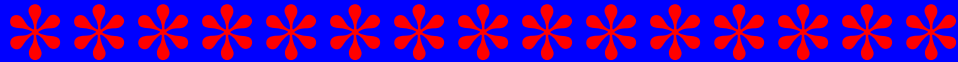

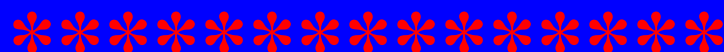
Our friend Rob sent this cool pic.

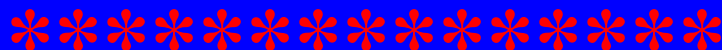


Scripture for the month.

Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people He chose for His inheritance.

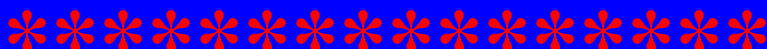

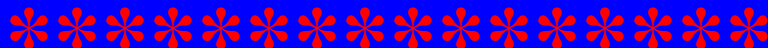
